<b>Language requirements</b>	<p>Students are required to have <b>B2</b> French language level. <b>Nomination</b>	<p>Before starting the admission procedure, students must have been nominated by their home institution. <b>Application</b>	<p>The application periods are May 15<sup>th</sup> – June 15<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup> – December 15<sup>th</sup></p> <p>The procedure and admission letters will be sent by email to the nominated students at the end of the nomination period. A proof of language efficiency will be required.</p>
